# APPENDIX D - CREDIT EQUIVALENCY BY LICENSURE, CERTIFICATION, MILITARY EXPERIENCE, OR STATE SEAL OF BILITERACY (500.26)

A student who has already obtained an industry recognized license or certification, for which the college offers a career and technical certificate or degree curriculum; a student who has evidence of a State Seal of Biliteracy on his/her transcript; a student who has successfully completed a military training course or program as part of his/her military service may be granted credit based on the tables below.

IECC does not accept credit for licensure, certification, military experience, or State Seal of Biliteracy that was awarded at other institutions. Credit awarded via this procedure will not be used to award financial aid or veteran's benefits.

Following are the request and approval processes:

### A. Credit Equivalency by Licensure or Certification

- Student must confer with an advisor to begin the process and obtain the required recommendation/ signature on the Application for Credit Equivalency form. Applicant will provide any applicable licensing or certification information as well as authorization to contact appropriate authorities for verification purposes. Credit is limited to specific credentials as outlined in Table 1. Additional experience and/or documentation may be required.
- 2. Student will then submit the application to the dean of instruction who will review and approve/ deny it, considering the currency of licensure or certification.
- 3. Approved applications will be forwarded to the registrar where the credit will be posted to the student's academic record, **but not before**:
  - fifteen (15) credit hours have been completed at IECC (for degree-seeking students);
  - twenty-five (25) percent of the required credits for the certificate have been completed at IECC (for certificate-seeking students).

### B. Credit Equivalency by State Seal of Biliteracy

- Student must confer with an advisor to begin the process and obtain the required recommendation/ signature on the Application for Credit Equivalency form. Credit is limited to the course equivalencies outlined in Table 2.
- Student will then submit the application to the dean of instruction who will review and approve it, confirming the student's high school transcript contains the certified State Seal of Biliteracy designation and ensuring the student graduated within 3 academic years of making application for the credit.

- 3. Approved applications will be forwarded to the registrar where the credit will be posted to the student's academic record, **but not before**:
  - fifteen (15) credit hours have been completed at IECC (for degree-seeking students);
  - twenty-five (25) percent of the required credits for the certificate have been completed at IECC (for certificate-seeking students).

#### C. Credit Equivalency by Military Experience

Credit equivalencies will only be granted to students who have successfully completed a military training course that is recommended for credit by American Council of Education (ACE), included in the student's military transcript issued by any branch of the armed services, or otherwise documented as military training or experience.

- Student must confer with an advisor to begin the process and obtain the required recommendation/ signature on the Application for Credit Equivalency form. Table 3 includes, but is not limited to, the various course equivalencies that may be granted as educational credit for military experience.
- 2. Student will then submit the application, official Joint Services Transcript, DD214, and any other pertinent documents to the dean of instruction who will approve/deny it, considering the applicability to corresponding IECC courses.
- 3. Approved applications will be forwarded to the registrar where the credit will be posted to the student's academic record, **but not before**:
  - fifteen (15) credit hours have been completed at IECC (for degree-seeking students);
  - twenty-five (25) percent of the required credits for the certificate have been completed at IECC (for certificate-seeking students).
