## **Preventing Sexual Misconduct at IECC**

## It is your right to report (or not report) an instance of sexual harassment or assault.



## What is Consent?

Consent is freely given agreement to sexual activity. Consent can be witdrawn at any time. Consent cannot be given when a person is unable to understand the nature of the activity or cannot consent based on circumstances including but not limited to:

- Incapacitation due to the influence of drugs or alcohol
- The person is asleep or unconscious
- The person is not of legal age to consent
- If the threat of force is used
- The person is incapacitated due to a mental disability

Consent must be given each time parties engage in sexual activity. Consent given on a prior occasion does not indicate future consent.

## How to Report Sexual Misconduct

SAFE provides free, confidential advisors. These advisors are not required to report any information about an incident to the Title IX Coordinator without a victim's permission.
