

LINCOLN TRAIL COLLEGE THEATER RENAISSANCE

For nearly five decades, the Zwermann Arts Center has been a hub for the musicians, dancers, thespians, and artists of Crawford County. Lincoln Trail College and the Lincoln Trail College Foundation are committed to maintaining this tradition for future generations. With your help we can work to make sure area residents continue to have access to a high quality cultural arts program. Over the next two years our Theater Renaissance campaign will seek to raise awareness and funds to support our efforts to renovate and revitalize our theater and music department. With the support of our community, it is anticipated that this campaign will have two distinct phases.

PHASE 1 RENOVATION & REVITALIZATION

The first phase of our campaign will address the urgent upgrades necessary to maintain a high quality program at Lincoln Trail College.

- **Curtains** The main and mid-traveler rails are bent and no longer operate properly. The curtains are old and in poor repair. \$46,000 for new rails and curtains. (\$15,000 of this need has already been secured).
- **Lighting** The stage lighting system at the college is outdated and no longer functioning properly. The lighting is halogen which is expensive and can be dangerous to operate. The lighting board is old and no longer accepting programming properly. \$60,000 for LED lights and a new lighting board.
- **Theater seats** A number of the seats in the theater are in need of mechanical and cosmetic repairs. \$3,000 for repairs to seats. (\$500 of this need has already been secured).
- **Music Room** The music room has become an overflow area for all things related to the theater and music programs. \$2,000 to repair and paint walls (\$1,000 of this need has already been secured). \$4,000 to resurface the floors (\$500 of this need has already been secured).
- **Dressing rooms** The dressing rooms have not been renovated since the 1970s. They are dated and in need of repair. \$3,000 for new cabinets, countertops and lights.



PHASE 2 REDISCOVERY

The cultural arts program at LTC has outgrown its current facilities. The rooms in the Zwermann Arts Center are filled to overflowing with the various items necessary to maintain vibrant programs. With strong support from our community, it is our hope that Lincoln Trail College will be able to work with the leadership of IECC to explore the feasibility of an addition to the Zwermann Arts Center. This proposed addition would:

- Support the curriculum of the theater, construction technology, and dual credit programs.
- Provide needed space for production of sets and storage of props, costumes, risers, and other goods used in the cultural arts program.
- Enhance the functionality of our existing facilities by removing clutter and creating environments more conducive to learning.
- Be located on the south side of Zwermann Arts Center and be one of the first facilities seen by the public as the drive on to campus.
