Overview

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to a Frontier Community College student pursuing a one-year certificate or two-year Associate's Degree. The FCC Adult Education Foundation Scholarship is open to non-traditional students. Adult Education graduates from any of the four IECC colleges may be eligible to apply. This scholarship will provide a \$2,500 award towards a student's tuition, books, supplies, and fees. The selected recipient will be chosen based on their academic record while in the IECC program, their demonstrated commitment to furthering their education through their IECC Adult Education experience, and their goals provided through the scholarship essay. The recipient will be notified before the beginning of the following semester.
