- DESCRIPTION:** The Maintenance / Custodian position is a full-time position that performs general maintenance and custodial duties under the supervision of the Operations and Maintenance Team Leader. This position is responsible for performing custodial duties and semi-skilled maintenance duties, including but not limited to; preparing the gym for ballgames, moving bleachers, cleaning assigned areas, and performing minor equipment repair, plumbing, carpentry, and building repairs; regulating, maintaining, and inspecting heating/cooling systems; and reporting conditions/safety hazards to supervisor. This position works second shift, and includes some weekend shifts.
- QUALIFICATIONS:** High school diploma, work experience in building maintenance, and experience in a teamwork environment. A valid driver's license and the ability to lift 50 lbs. on a continuous, repetitive basis also required.
- WAGES/BENEFITS:** \$12.31 to \$14.16 per hour, based upon knowledge and experience. Benefits include, but are not limited to: medical, dental, and life insurance; paid sick leave, vacation, and personal days; and participation in State Universities Retirement System.
